June 16, 2022

The Grandview City Council met in a special called session on Thursday, June 16, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.

- I. Meeting was called to order by Mayor Stewart at 6:30 p.m.
- II. Invocation was given by Mayor Stewart.
- III. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilmember Goltz.
- IV. PUBLIC COMMENTS – No Comments
- V. NEW BUSINESS
 1. **Discuss and take possible action on a replat of a tract of land located in the F.L. Kirtley Survey, Abstract No. 480, Johnson County, Texas, being all of Lot 2 and Lot 3 and part of Lot 1 and Lot 4, Block 2, according to Plat recorded in Volume 57, Page 640, Plat Records, Johnson County at the request of Green Tower Enterprises LLC.** Mayor Pro-Tem Martin made a motion to approve the replat subject to the listed conditions in the Engineering Determination Letter per the city engineer. Councilmember Medenwaldt seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.

2. **Discuss and take possible action on Ordinance 2022-0616, an ordinance of the City of Grandview, Texas, temporarily closing certain streets or portions thereof, for the Grandview Fourth of July Event and October 8, 2022 Concert; prohibiting vehicular access to certain streets or portions of the streets during temporary closure periods; and providing for enforcement, and criminal penalties including fines not to exceed \$500 per offense.** Councilmember Goltz made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-0616 as presented. Councilmember Welch seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.
3. **Discuss and take possible action on Ordinance 2022-0616A, an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Grandview, Texas, reappointing Toni Driver to the position of Municipal Judge; Reappointing Terri Wilson to the position of Alternate Judge; providing that this ordinance be cumulative of all ordinances; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.** Councilmember Welch made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-0616A as presented. Councilmember Goltz seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.
4. **Discuss and take possible action on Resolution 2022-0616B, a resolution of the City Council of the City of Grandview, Texas accepting the donation of certain real property from Johnson County, Texas; designation the property to be used for public purpose of public works operation; and providing an effective date.** Councilmember Medenwaldt made a motion to table this until further research can be done. Councilmember Welch seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.
5. **Discuss and take possible action on reappointing Les Carney, Place 6, to the Planning and Zoning Commission for a two-year term, ending June 30, 2024.** Councilmember Welch made a motion to reappoint Les Carney; Place 6 to the Planning and Zoning Commission for a two-year term ending June 30, 2024. Mayor Pro-Tem Martin seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.
6. **Discuss and take possible action on reappointing Stewart Bogard, Place 2, and Rob Wallace, Place 6, to the Type A EDC board for a two-year term, ending June 30, 2024.** Mayor Pro-Tem Martin made a motion to reappoint Stewart Bogard, Place 2, and Rob Wallace, Place 6 to the Type A EDC board for a two-year term, ending June 30, 2024. Councilmember Goltz seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.
7. **Discuss and take possible action on reappointing Kathrine Stewart, Place 4, and Daphne Young, Place 6, to the Type B EDC board for a two-year term, ending June 30, 2024.** Councilmember Martin made a motion to reappoint Kathrine Stewart, Place 4 and Daphne Young, Place 6 to the Type B EDC board for a two-year term, ending June 30, 2024. The motion died for lack of a second. Councilmember Welch made a motion to reappoint Daphne Young, Place 6 to the Type B EDC board for a two-year term, ending June 30, 2024. Councilmember Goltz seconded the motion. Motion carried – all ayes.
8. **Executive session pursuant to the Open Meeting Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, Sec. 551.071.** No executive session was necessary.
9. **The City Council reconvened into regular session pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code to take any**

action necessary regarding matters deliberated in executive session.
Council did not adjourn into executive session.
